CitiCare Reaches \$2.2 Million and Continues to Provide ACCESS Rides to Outlying Areas of Reno/Sparks

CitiCare recently exceeded the \$2.2 million mark in fundraising, thanks to the generous help from private donations, local, state and federal organizations. CitiCare has used this money to purchase paratransit rides for people with significant disabilities, in the Reno/Sparks area since 2001.

CitiCare is in its eighth year of a Federal Transit Administration New Freedom Initiative grant, which provides rides to people traveling to the non-ADA service area. These are the outlying areas of Reno/Sparks, where federal law does not mandate service, so where service is often denied to people with disabilities. This FTA grant requires a 50/50 match so CitiCare must match every federal dollar with a non-federal dollar to fully utilize the New Freedom grant. Every year, generous donations have made it possible to bring in the full amount of each federal grant and provide the maximum number of rides to people with disabilities. These rides are used for medical services, employment, shopping, and other services as well as social opportunities.

CitiCare is an independent, nonprofit organization with local volunteers in Reno, with an an innovative approach to expanding the current transportation services for people with disabilities in our community. CitiCare purchases paratransit rides from the Regional Transportation Commission (RTC), which creates increased transportation availability for people with disabilities without costly capital expenditures or administrative costs. Best of all, there is no duplication of services or "re-inventing the wheel." We depend on RTC ACCESS' well trained and qualified staff who operate the paratransit system making the process seamless for the riders. Since 2001, CitiCare has raised over \$2.2 million in funds, and has purchased over 92,000 incremental paratransit rides for approximately 3,500 riders. Unlike other non-profit organizations, no grant money is spent for personnel or other human resource costs.
